

Reforestation & Carbon Credit Assistant

TreeFolks seeks a dedicated and detail-oriented Reforestation & Carbon Credit Assistant to support our mission of enhancing Central Texas' urban and floodplain forests. The Reforestation & Carbon Credit Assistant will collaborate closely with the Reforestation Coordinator on TreeFolks' Central Texas Floodplain Reforestation Program (CTFRP) and Carbon Credit Program. This hybrid role includes remote, office-based, and fieldwork, with travel to various private and public planting sites across a 7-county region of Central Texas. The successful candidate will assist in reforestation efforts, including tree care, mapping, carbon credit reporting, and program development.

Position Details:

This is a full-time, permanent, exempt position. TreeFolks offers a competitive salary, plus health benefits, generous vacation time, a flexible schedule, a casual work environment, and professional development opportunities. The starting minimum salary is **\$46,592 annually**, based on experience, qualifications, and additional attributes, such as bilingualism or firsthand knowledge of the communities in which TreeFolks works.

- Start Date: April 1, 2025
- Schedule: Approximately 40 hours per week, Monday through Friday, with occasional weekend work. During the planting season (late fall to late winter), the role demands flexibility to work consecutive 12-15 hour days for several weeks until planting is completed. Overtime hours will be flexed off immediately following the completion of contractor plantings.

Key Responsibilities:

- Assist in implementing City Forest Credit (CFC) protocols and carbon project reports
- Conduct canopy growth assessments using ArcGIS, Lens Satellite Imagery, and Excel
- Create annual monitoring reports for registered carbon projects
- Assist with designing GIS maps for reforestation planting sites
- Capture verification photos at planting sites following CFC protocols
- Organize, care for, and manage 30,000–70,000 seedling trees, including watering, pruning, and labeling
- Aid in supervising tree planting crews and volunteers, ensuring proper care and quality control
- Assist with preparing planting sites, transporting trees and equipment using TreeFolks' trucks and trailers
- Contribute to creating educational and outreach materials
- Provide excellent customer service via email and phone
- Assist in community outreach efforts to promote reforestation services and register landowners
- Support event planning and execution, including volunteer coordination

- Utilize iPads, Trimble, and ArcGIS Field Maps app for final mapping and site preparation
- Maintain reforestation program vehicles, trailers, and watering rigs, ensuring safety and operational standards

- Required:
 - Strong attention to detail and ability to maintain meticulous records for carbon reporting
 - GIS mapping experience
 - Ability to work independently with minimal supervision
 - Excellent written and verbal communication skills
 - Ability to read, write, and speak in English
 - Ability to repeatedly lift and carry up to 25 lbs for extended periods
 - Willingness to work outdoors in all weather conditions, including extreme temperatures and rain
 - Ability to walk on uneven terrain and overgrown properties for fieldwork and site preparation
 - Flexibility to work a variable schedule when needed
 - Valid Texas driver's license with a clean driving record
 - Positive attitude and customer service orientation
- Preferred:
 - Knowledge of trees and tree care
 - Ability to drive a truck and trailer
 - Spanish language proficiency

Success in this position will include:

- Effective implementation of reforestation protocols, including accurate canopy growth assessments and timely carbon project reporting.
- Exceptional attention to detail in GIS mapping, record-keeping, and ensuring high-quality planting practices.
- Meticulous care and management of saplings, including watering, pruning, mulching, and organizing trees in the nursery.
- Successful collaboration with the Reforestation team and community stakeholders to promote reforestation initiatives and engage volunteers.
